

Charge to the Church..... *Elder Robert Whittaker*

Hebrews 13:7, 17 — “Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the Word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation. Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.

Receive it not as the word of men, but what the Word of God expects of you as members of his flock. Listen eagerly to his preaching of the Word, receiving it not as a word of men, but the Word of God. Take to heart his scriptural words of warning and encouragement, humbly accepting the Word planted in you. Work together with him for our Lord's kingdom so that by your works of service the Body of Christ might be built up. Honor him and love him. The apostle Paul says: "Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Pray for him continually, that his ministry among you may be greatly blessed."

Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil. ” (I Timothy 3:1-4, 6, 7)


